

NORTH BRANDON LAKE NOTICE

Decals are required for every boat on the Lake as well as all vehicles left at the boat launch.

ANY BOAT WITHOUT A DECAL WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE LAKE! VIOLATORS ARE SUBJECT TO ACTION BY THE RANKIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

The Lake Committee has been working to enforce the rules pertaining to the lake. The number of trespassers has declined since the implementation of the new decals and keys. Having the proper decals displayed on boats and vehicles is vitally important in helping prevent use of North Brandon Lake by nonmembers. Nonmembers using North Brandon Lake add additional pressure on the fish and remove fish without regard to our harvest guidelines. These harvest guidelines are established by Southeastern Pond Management to maintain the lake as a quality trophy bass fishery.

Please help us watch for boats without decals! The only person that can protect North Brandon Lake from poaching is you! Please call one of the committee members below if you are not comfortable confronting someone that does not have a decal.

Please note the following:

- 1) Any vehicle left unattended at the boat ramp area not bearing a current numbered NBSHOA decal will be towed at the owner's expense.
- 2) All persons trespassing at the boat ramp area and/or on North Brandon Lake without an Owner accompanying that person will be prosecuted for trespassing.
THIS INCLUDES PERSONS UTILIZING OWNER'S BOATS WITHOUT THE OWNER PRESENT.
- 3) Any NBSHOA member observed on the lake without the proper decals will be asked to leave until they obtain the proper decals. Failure to comply will result in a **\$50** fine.
It is the responsibility of each member to obtain decals prior to using North Brandon Lake.
- 4) Any NBSHOA member that gives permission and/or access to North Brandon Lake to non-owners or violates harvest guidelines will be fined **\$50** for a first offense. On the second offense privileges to North Brandon Lake will be suspended for a period of one (1) year. Any NBSHOA member that allows their key to be duplicated or otherwise obtained by non-members will have their privileges to North Brandon Lake suspended for a period of one (1) year.
- 5) Members or persons under 18 years of age are prohibited from being on the common areas, including the boat ramp area and community center, after dark without an adult Member present.
- 6) Any member that is not current on Association assessments may not use North Brandon Lake or the Community Center. A member in past due status found on the Lake or on Community Center property will be considered a trespassor and will be subject to such action and fines as the County deems appropriate.
